Lord Ara Darzi of Denham studied medicine at the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland. Darzi holds the Paul Hamlyn Chair of Surgery at Imperial College London and the Institute of Cancer Research, where he is one of the world's leading specialists in the field of minimally invasive and robot-assisted surgery and allied technologies. In 2007 Darzi was appointed Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State at the Department of Health and was tasked to carry out a wide-ranging review of the NHS to ensure that "a properly resourced NHS be clinically led, patient-centred and locally accountable." His work forms the basis for strategic reform within the NHS.
